MISSION TEAM DEVELOPMENT

We ask congregations to send mature men to the school so that when they graduate they will be able to serve the church right away. However many times they send us the younger men. When the younger men returned to Sulawesi to serve the church they carried with them knowledge but also they became just a little arrogant in it's use.
